Each application set must include:

- **A completed International Cessna 190/195 Foundation Scholarship Application Form**
 - This form may be downloaded at www.cessna195.org/foundation
- **Printed transcripts from all high schools, colleges, flight or trade schools verifying GPAs.**
- **A 500 word, typed descriptive essay that details:**
 - The training for which you need assistance
 - Your aviation history and goals
 - How the scholarship will help you achieve your goals
 - What you have done for yourself to achieve your goals
 - Where you see yourself in five and ten years
 - Where and when you will obtain and complete your training
 - Any previous educational scholarships, awards, and honors.
 - Your present financial need
- **Your professional resume**
 - Include three (3) references (at least one (1) from an aviation or aeronautical professional).

In addition, IF APPLICABLE, copies of:

- All aviation licenses
- Medical certificate
- The last three (3) pages of your pilot logbook

The selection criteria will include:

- Attitude towards self and others
- Commitment to success
- Dedication to career
- Financial need
- Previous achievements

Applications must be postmarked by May 1 of each year to be eligible for award for the fall semester. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
